Admission to **The Santa Fe Show** is \$12 per person (or \$16 for the run of show) with children under 16 admitted free. Visitors to downtown Santa Fe can ride the free “Santa Fe Pick-Up” shuttle service to **The Santa Fe Show** and The New Mexico Rail Runner Express train’s Santa Fe Depot stop is a block from the venue. There is ample parking at the Railyard’s nearby underground garage and refreshments will be available at **The Santa Fe Show’s** café.
