Santa Fe Animal Shelter To Benefit from The Santa Fe Show Preview Party

(For immediate release, Santa Fe, NM) The Santa Fe Animal Shelter and Humane Society will be the beneficiary of the first opening night preview of The Santa Fe Show, Objects of Art. The festive event will be held Friday, August 12, from 6:00 – 9:00 at El Museo Cultural de Santa Fe. It will provide an opportunity to be among the first to see and shop at the Show.

The Santa Fe Show, Objects of Art, is a unique antiques and art show that serves as a compliment to the city's traditional Ethnographic and Indian Market weekends.
