The Santa Fe Show Adds Two Book Signings

(For immediate release, Santa Fe, NM) The Santa Fe Show, Objects of Art has just announced two note-worthy book signings scheduled for the show's final weekend.

On Thursday, August 18 at 7pm, Jim Arndt, nationally recognized advertising and editorial photographer, will be signing his book, "Art of Turquoise" by Mary Emmerling (Smith, Gibbs Publisher). The book features collectible pieces that serve to reveal the attraction of this icon of the American Southwest.

Bille Hougart will sign copies of "The Little Book of Marks on Southwestern Silver: Silversmiths, Designers, Guilds & Traders" (TBR International) on Friday, August 19 at 11am. Featuring over 3,200 entries, Hougart's book serves to detail and explain the marks found on silver pieces produced in the Southwest.

The Santa Fe Show, Objects of Art, is a unique antiques and art show that serves as a compliment to the city's traditional Ethnographic and Indian Market weekends. This boutique event will feature an elite selection of more than 60 vendors presenting outstanding examples of art and design in a wide range of media and historic periods including the work of living artists. The emphasis throughout The Santa Fe Show will be on the aesthetic importance and design significance of the works presented by galleries, artists and designers.

The Santa Fe Show will be open to the public for its closing weekend from August 19 through 21, from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm each day. A festive "Second Opening" will be held on Thursday, August 18, from 6:00 – 9:00pm. Daily admission to **The Santa Fe Show** is \$12 per person (or \$16 for the run of show) with children under 16 admitted free and \$50 per person for the August 18 "Second Opening".
